Casual workers - housekeepers

£7/hour + holiday pay

We have an ongoing requirement for reliable people to sign up as casual workers to work as housekeepers.

This work involves some heavy lifting and each person is allotted specific rooms to clean.

Full training is provided with an induction programme. Work is available at weekends and/or during the week and hours required are typically 10-2pm.

Casual work is available to assist at peak periods, specific functions and general requirements throughout the year.

Casual work would be paid for on a zero hours basis, allowing people the flexibility to fit their casual work around college, university, additional employment, domestic and other priorities.

Our casual workers are paid for the hours they work and also receive holiday pay. They share access to free parking, gym and pool facilities and, depending on the hours worked, can also be provided with a meal.

The minimum pay rate is typically £7 per hour, with 12.07% paid for holiday pay.

Our appointment process involves an application form, brief interview and at least one trial shift without payment.
